DOUBLE COLUMNAR TRANSPOSITION – RELOADED (PART 2)

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Introduction

After the level X challenge "Double Columnar Transposition" was solved for the first time (using some remarkable new ideas), we decided to create a series of new double columnar transposition challenges. In these new level III challenges we considered the newly discovered vulnerabilities and created three new ones with increasing difficulty.

The solution consists of the first 37 characters of the original English plaintext in capital letters without any spaces.

Hints

- ▶ The key length for both keys is 20 - 27 characters.
- ▶ The key lengths are co-prime (as with the original level X challenge).
- ▶ Both keys are chosen randomly.
- ▶ The plaintext consists of two English texts interleaved word by word.
- ▶ You can download an additional file that contains only the ciphertext.
